



Oceano installation guide

Oceano filters are quick to install. Here is a simple step-by-step installation guide:

1. Turn off the cold-water supply

Turn off the water supply to the cold-water connection, either at the main shut-off valve or at the small valve under the sink, if available.

Locate the cold-water connection and disconnect the cold-water hose from your kitchen tap.

2. Mount the filter

The filter can be mounted horizontally or vertically on the wall. It does not need to remain upright to function correctly.

3. Connect the hoses

Attach the supplied hoses to each side of the filter housing. Please note that the filter has an inlet and an outlet, indicated by arrows.

The two supplied hoses are different:

- One connects the filter housing to the cold-water supply.
- The other connects the filter housing to the disconnected hose from your kitchen tap.

Once both hoses have been attached securely to the filter housing, connect the inlet hose to the cold-water supply. Then connect the second hose from the filter housing to the loose hose from your kitchen tap that you previously disconnected.

4. Turn the water back on

Slowly turn the water supply back on and check all connections for leaks.

If you notice a leak, the hoses or filter cartridge may need to be tightened, depending on where the leak occurs.

Allow the water to run for five minutes to flush any excess carbon particles from the filter.

5. Replacing the filter cartridge

To replace the cartridge, push the small red tab upwards. Turn the cartridge 90 degrees clockwise and remove it.
